OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST – SECONDARY SCHOOLS WITH REDUCED RATES OF SUSPENSION AND EXCLUSION

I refer to your email dated 11 February 2019 to the Education Review Office.

In your email you set out the background to your request as follows:

My name is ██████████ and I am a PhD student researching the prevention of suspension and exclusion from school.

I am keen to get an idea on a few mainstream schools (4 - 5) you have evaluated in the past 5 - 10 years that have had historically high numbers of suspensions and exclusions, but have implemented initiatives to reduce rates of suspension and exclusion, and have experienced success. I am also interested in those schools who have not experienced success, but who continue to strive for reduced rates of suspension and exclusion.
