2021 October Baseline Update Submission for Vote Education Review Office

Purpose

1. I am seeking your agreement to ERO's 2021 October Baseline Update submission.

Background

- 2. The attached submission to the Minister of Finance documents changes to the baseline for Vote Education Review Office for the 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24, 2024/25 and 2025/26 financial years.
- 3. The changes consist of a:
 - Expense or Capital Transfer for an in-principle expense transfer of \$0.5 million approved by Joint Ministers in March 2021 to progress 2020/21 evaluation programme deferred to 2021/22 due to disruptions arising from COVID-19. It was agreed that the amount would be confirmed after the 2020/21 audited financial statements, which has now been completed. The amount to be transferred is \$0.454 million.
 - Forecast change in departmental capital expenditure in 2021/22 to reflect ERO's latest capital replacement programme. This mainly includes the timing of expenditure on computer software which was carried forward from 2020/21 to 2021/22 due to disruptions arising from COVID-19.
