2020 October Baseline Update Submission for Vote Education Review Office

Purpose

1. I am seeking your agreement to ERO's 2020 October Baseline Update submission.

Background

- 2. The attached submission to the Minister of Finance documents changes to the baseline for Vote Education Review Office for the 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25 financial years.
- 3. The changes consist of a:
 - Technical changes to incorporate the decrease in the capital charge rate from 6% to 5% in 2020/21 and the outyears. This has resulted in a decrease of \$39,000 in departmental output expense appropriation for these years matched by an equivalent decrease in Revenue Crown in 2020/21 and outyears.
 - Technical change for an in-principle expense transfer of \$1.0 million approved by Joint Ministers in June 2020 to progress 2019/20 evaluation programme deferred to 2020/21 due to disruptions arising from COVID-19. It was agreed that this amount would be confirmed after the 2019/20 audited financial statements, which has now been completed.
 - Fiscally neutral adjustment in 2020/21 has been made in the output Evaluations of the Quality of Education to reflect the latest forecast levels of revenue from contractual services.
 - Forecast change in departmental capital expenditure in 2020/21 to reflect ERO's latest capital replacement programme. This includes the timing of expenditure on computer software which was carried forward from 2019/20 to 2020/21 due to disruptions arising from COVID-19 and some leasehold improvements to Christchurch and Wellington premises.
