Education Review Office Strategic Intentions 2023-2026

1. Under Section 44 of the Public Finance Act (the Act), ERO is required to present our strategic intentions (SOI) for 2023-2026 this year. This builds on our last SOI covering the 2020-2024 period.
2. We have attached to this briefing a draft copy of our 2023-2026 SOI for your review and agreement to table in the House as soon as practicable (as required under the Act).
3. In developing our 2023-2026 SOI, we have considered ERO's evolving context since the previous period. This has included a focus on:
 - The ongoing impacts of COVID-19 across the sector.
 - The changing needs of the sector.
 - Accommodations needed for the planned reform of the education system.
 - The onboarding of the departmental agency Aroturuki Tamariki – the Independent Children's Monitor.


