**Re: Official Information Act request for total remuneration positions between \$95k and \$100k**

I refer to your email to the Education Review Office dated 29 April 2024 requesting information under the Official Information Act 1982 as follows:

*Total remuneration positions between \$95k and \$100k*

We have interpreted your question to refer to current ERO employees.

ERO uses base salary as the basis for our remuneration. As ERO is a small agency with limited systems, information based on total remuneration is not available in an accessible format without substantial research or collation under section 18(f) of the OIA. Doing this would have a significant and unreasonable impact on ERO's ability to carry out its other operations.

In light of this, I provide the information below based on base salary only.

ERO employs 24.5 FTE between \$95k and \$100k. This is made up of a headcount of 23 full time staff and another two part time staff whose base salary would fall within that range were they full time.

Please note that it is our policy to proactively release our responses to official information requests where possible. We do not publish requesters' personal information.
